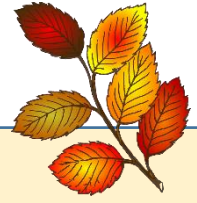




# Class 4 Newsletter

## Routines

### Reading

Our topic for this term is 'Everyone's a Winner'. As part of this topic, your child will be learning about the ancient Greeks. We are reading Percy Jackson and the Lightning Thief as our class reader. In science we will be learning about materials and their properties. In English, we will be writing our own newspaper reports, stories and travel brochures as well as revising key concepts. We will continue to follow the White Rose scheme of learning in maths, which begins with a focus on securing understanding of numbers and place value, recapping previous year's objectives.
