Starlings Curriculum Map Spring Term

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English

Responsibility

This half term we are learning to write a warning story. The pupils will learn a Pie Corbett story 'The Caravan' using talk for writing. They will then write their own warning stories. Pupils will also be learning to write persuasive letters. After half term, we will be learning to write scary stories and speeches.

Geography

What places were connected by the Silk Road? Pupils will be learning about the Silk Road and linking this to their learning about the Romans. They will compare places along the Silk Road with the UK such as Italy and China. They will learn about the goods that were traded by these countries.

ODL & Art



During ODL this half term the pupils will be learning outdoor practical skills such as team building, tree planting, bushcraft and fire pit activities. After half term they are learning to make collages. They will be studying the work of the artist Matisse.

Science

How can we identify solids, liquids and gases? In science the pupils are learning about states of matter. They will learn to identify materials as solids, liquids and gases. They will also investigate how materials can change state and about the water cycle. After half term pupils will be learning about the parts of flowering plants and their life cycles.

History

What does the Romanisation of Britain mean? This half term the pupils are learning about life in Roman Britain. They will learn about the Roman Empire and why the Romans invaded Britain. They will learn about the movement of people and items across the Roman Empire and how this created a multicultural society in Britain.

Global Citizenship

Our themes for this term are Identity & Diversity and Globalisation and Interdependence.

PE

This half term the pupils are learning to explore movement through dance through improvisation, dancing in unison, canon and creating sequences taking on the character of cats. After half term they will be learning to play tag rugby.

Music

This half term pupils will be learning to sing and perform the song 'Stop'. They will also compose their own rap songs.



Maths



This half term the children are focussing on multiplication and division. They will learn how to multiply/divide 2 or 3 digit numbers by 1 digit numbers. They will also be learning to measure the length, perimeter and area of a shape. After half term pupils will be learning to find fractions of an amount and how to identify equivalent fractions.



PSHE How can I achieve my goals?

This half term pupils will be learning about their dreams and goals. They will learn to make a plan for their goals and think about how they can overcome obstacles along the way. After half term the pupils will be learning about healthy lifestyles. They will learn about healthy eating as well as the effects of smokina and alcohol on their health.

This half term the pupils will be learn to code using the programme Scratch within computing lessons. **How do religious groups contribute to society?** Pupils will be learning about Christianity and Hinduism in RE. They will explore how religious beliefs are practiced both locally and globally.
