In PE we will be learning how to hit a ball using a racket and a bat and begin preparing for sports day.

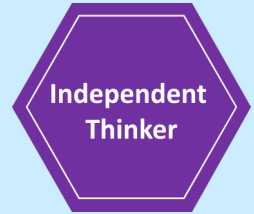
We will continue to develop dexterity in our fingers through fine motor activities and to form letters correctly through daily handwriting sessions.

Understanding the world

How do we know dinosaurs existed?

We will begin by considering the past and how long ago dinosaurs walked the earth before there were humans. We will learn about the famous palaeontologist Mary Anning and that everything we know about dinosaurs comes from fossils. We will then go on a deep history coast trip to Cromer and hunt for our own fossils.

What can you see at the seaside?

We will consider changes over time at the seaside such as clothing and transport. We will also consider environmental changes to our coastlines and think about how we can help to take better care of our beaches. We will also learn about some of the different creatures which live in the sea.

Literacy

We will continue using Read write Inc. to teach phonic sounds, and are now learning the set 2 sounds. We will continue to segment and blend words together, read common words and will be challenging ourselves to write captions and short sentences in preparation for starting year one.

We will explore a wide range of stories to develop story language for retelling. Our talk for writing sessions will support this and the text we will be using is 'Ten terrible dinosaurs' By Paul Stickland.
