Barn Owls have already been using the library for their computing lessons.



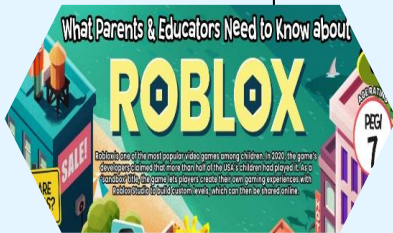
E-safety
