Message from Mrs Softley – Robins Class

Robins have started noticing the changes as autumn is bringing this week and have enjoyed creating with leaves and making pumpkin slime!

In Drawing Club, we are exploring the story *Stuck* By Oliver Jeffers and have been exploring all the nouns which could get stuck in a tree. The year ones and twos have extended this by learning how to make a noun plural and when we need to add 'es' instead of just an 's'.

In maths, the early years children are learning about making pairs and sets and have been thinking about the different sets we see around us such as when we lay the table and have enjoyed learning how to play snap. The year 1s and 2s are starting to add 2 numbers together quickly by learning number bonds within 10 and how they can do this systematically.

This week has been full of exciting discoveries in Red Kites! For science, we explored the different types of teeth in our mouths and their functions.
