### Message from Mrs Softley – Robins Class

Robins have been really lucky to have lots of grown ups visit them this week to tell them all about their jobs. We have been considering what we would like to do when we are older and have learnt lots about careers we had never thought about before.

In Drawing Club, we have been looking at Goldilocks and the three bears and have finished the week with an apology from Goldilocks to the Bears for all the unkind things she did while she was in their house.

In maths, Key Stage 1 have been learning about doubling and how they can use doubling facts to solve near double addition problems. Early years have been deepening their understanding of the numbers 1 to 3 so that they can quickly recognise patterns of objects and numerals and represent them using their fingers.

### Message from Mr Lamoureux – Red Kites Class

What a fantastic week of learning and creativity we have had in Red Kites! In Maths, the children have been adding and subtracting 100s, 10s, and 1s. In English, we have been exploring the world of poetry and learning all about awesome alliteration (see what I did there?) and onomatopoeia, creating sentences that sound as fun as they read! Art has been exciting; the children built the structure of their own totem poles using the toilet roll tubes kindly donated by everyone. In PE, we have been putting into practice the fundamental movement skills we have learned so far this term through team-based games, focusing on coordination, agility, balance, throwing and catching. The children have also been enjoying

their ODL sessions with Mrs Walker, where they have been learning about different knots - tying, twisting and mastering some tricky techniques to create natural creations.
