Robins have had a very busy half term and our newest members are now all well settled into the class and the classroom routines.

Key stage 1 children have all made fantastic progress in their writing and finished this week by writing their own stories based around the structure of Rosie's walk. The early years children are all really enjoying drawing club and are developing fantastic imaginations and storytelling skills which will support them in Key Stage 1.

In Maths, early years children have learnt to subitise and build numbers up to 4 and can quickly show 1, 2 or 3 fingers or identify 1, 2 or 3 objects from a large group. Key Stage 1 children have developed their knowledge of place value and have been doing addition and subtraction within 20.

I hope you have a wonderful half term.

Message from Mr Lamoureux – Red Kites Class

What a busy and exciting half term it has been! The children been creative, curios and determined throughout. We have written diaries and poems. Tackled tricky place value, addition and subtraction problems and had thoughtful discussions about friendships, kindness and peaceful solutions. We have explored the human body from what foods and nutrients we eat, to teeth, the skeleton, muscles and the digestive system. We have read religious stories, got active in PE and travelled back in time to discover what life was like for the Anglo-Saxons.
