Children in Need

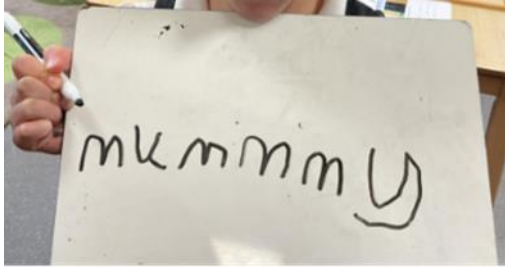
We have worked collaboratively today, baking, counting donations and dressing up to raise money for Children in Need. We will let you know how much we have raised after the 3pm bake sale.
