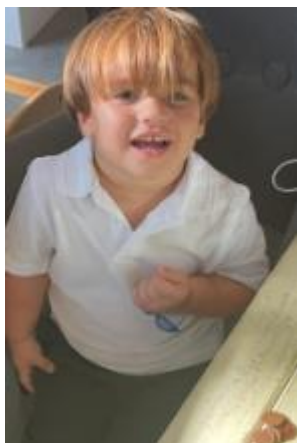

Message from Mrs Softley – Robins Class

Robins have been learning how to write letters this week and have been using these skills to write letters to Santa and Jesus. We have also been looking at the story of Rudolph the Red Nosed Reindeer and have written letters to other animals to ask them to help him and also to suggest to Rudolph some places he could go on holiday during the summer months.

In Maths, early years children are learning days of the week and months of the year and have started to make calendars. The key stage 1 children have finished their work on 3D shapes by learning about making symmetrical patterns.

In science, we have been learning about germs and the importance of washing our hands with soap. We conducted an experiment with glitter and couldn't believe how many objects had glitter on them if one person didn't wash their hands.

Message from Miss Davies – Red Kites Class

This week Red Kites have been working hard on expanded noun phrases and using them to make their story innovations more interesting to read. We have talked about medicines, what they are, what they are used for and how to be safe with them: ask your child to tell you what they learned! Maths involved the number 4 – multiplying and dividing. We have used grouping, sharing and an empty number line to divide. We have answered lots of questions about the daily text we have read, to practise retrieval skills. Reading at home regularly is hugely important; thank you for hearing your child read regularly. On Friday next week, we will be making special light-up boxes. Please send an empty cereal box in next week. Friday 12th is the last swim this term. Thankfully we can start again after Christmas – we have arranged another half term borrowing Warren School's mini bus.
