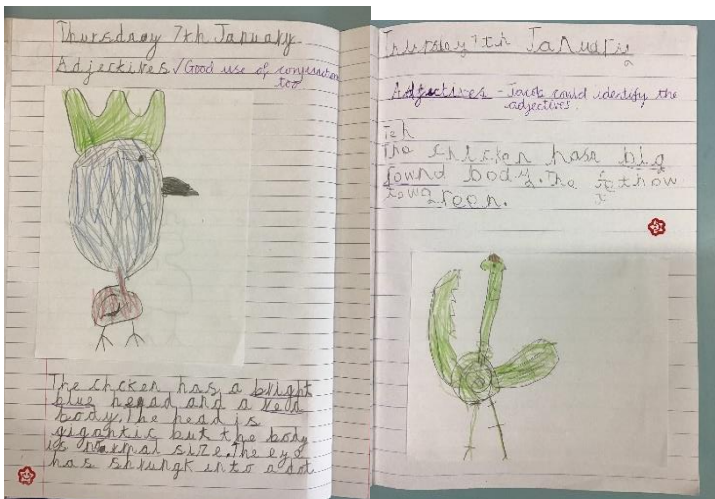
A timetable will be provided by the class teacher to show what subjects are being delivered and when. You will also know when to log on for the live lessons.
