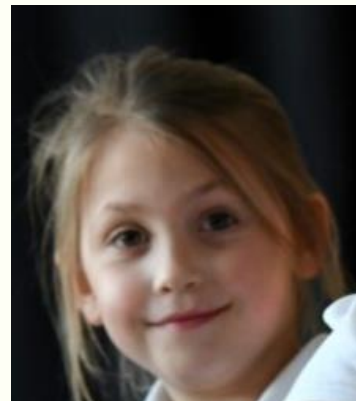
Stars of the Week

Message from Mrs Softley – Robins Class

Robins have been very busy this week, learning about earth, what it looks like from a great height and how we can represent this. We also have a space station set up in the classroom where the children have been encouraged to make passports, write packing lists and they have worked together to make a huge rocket to role play inside.

Key Stage 1 children have been learning about using different connectives to join 2 sentences together and make them more succinct and to offer choices.
