Message from Mrs Softley – Robins Class

Robins have had a fantastic end to the term this week and have been learning about why we celebrate Easter and how different people celebrate it around the world. We worked together to make our own hot cross buns and enjoyed sharing them with the grownups who came in for parent assembly.

The year 1 children have been learning about different ways we can represent data and have looked at block diagrams, tally charts and pictograms. We conducted our own surveys into staff and peers' favourite pets, colours and sports and used the information to make our own representations.

Early years children have been exploring repeating patterns and began by learning to do this physically e.g. clap, clap, stomp, stomp and progressed to do these using objects and then tried completing a pattern around a shape.

I hope you all have a wonderful Easter break and look forward to an exciting summer term when we return.

Message from Mr Lamoureux– Red Kites Class

This term has been shorter but full of exciting learning and meaningful experiences!

This week saw us develop our writing skills by creating recounts about our trip to Sutton Hoo and in maths, we have been building our understanding of fractions.
