#### Message from Mrs Softley – Robins Class

Robins had a fantastic trip to the Transport Museum this week. We enjoyed riding on the trams and the train and learning about different types of wheeled vehicles such as steam rollers and electric cars. In science this week, we have been learning about the different parts of a plant and how their shape and colour is useful for their functions. Early years children have been considering what the seaside was like in the past and have learnt that the railway brought the opportunity for many people to go to the coast for the first time which created a need for tourism and opportunities to travel to different places. In maths this week, early years children have been looking at 2D shape arrangements and thinking about how shapes can be manipulated and changed by combining them. Key stage 1 children have

started learning about fractions and have this week begun learning about finding half before moving onto quarters and thirds next week.

### Message from Mr Lamoureux– Red Kites Class

Monday was an exciting day! We were very lucky to have a visit from the RNLI, where we learned lots about water safety and how to respond in emergencies near water. The children asked great questions and gained some really valuable knowledge.

In English, we have been working hard on our narratives, focusing on describing settings and characters to make our stories more engaging. In Maths, we have completed our unit on fractions and have now moved on to learning about mass and capacity. We've been practising weighing objects and reading scales in grams and kilograms.

In Geography, we learned about the 8 points of the compass and used them to give and follow directions on a map. In RE, we explored different cultures, tasted foods from around the world, and had thoughtful discussions about multiculturalism.

We also made time for PE, outdoor learning, and swimming, keeping active and enjoying learning in different environments!
