The year ones have been working really hard to learn to tell the time – please make sure to continue practicing this skill at home! Early years children have been using their knowledge of position and orientation to instruct each other to create a pirate island and to go on a real life “Bear Hunt”!

In RE, we considered what the big question was this week and thought of some great “big questions” such as if God created the world then who created God and why can’t dogs talk? We discussed possible answers to these questions while gaining an understanding that there are some things we may never know for sure. This week, we have been busy exploring a narrative based on going on a magical journey. The children have been collecting and using lots of exciting descriptive vocabulary to help bring their writing to life. In maths, we have been learning how to add, subtract and find change when using money. The children have worked so hard and have confidently said they are now ready to spend all of their parents’ money! In science, we have been learning about human life cycles and discussing how humans grow and change over time. In geography, we looked at the course of a river and explored how it changes from the source to the mouth. In DT, we spoke about food, the importance of farmers and farming, and whether different foods are grown, reared or caught. We have also practised more cricket skills in PE. A fantastic week of learning, well done everyone!
