Message from Mrs Softley – Robins Class

Robins have had a great week this week looking at the text *Searching for treasure by Johanna Bell*. Key stage one has used this as inspiration to research and complete a fact file about a Sea Creatures and have been learning about the features of non-fiction texts. Early years children have considered other hunts the child could go on and have thought about how the beach might look from a crab's perspective. In maths, early years children have been consolidating their learning from throughout the year, and key stage one children have been finishing their learning about capacity and have consolidated their learning on direction and describing position. We finished the week by making prints using our own crafted string prints and using tennis balls and rackets to make a Wimbledon inspired piece of group art!
