Citizen of the Week – Logan, Reuben, Luca and Aurelia.

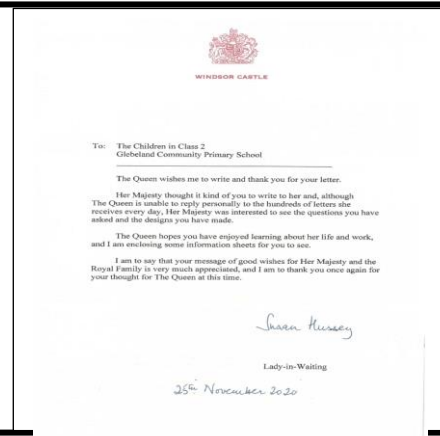
In addition to these awards we are continuing to send 'secret texts' to the parents of children who have worked really hard in lessons during the day.

She also sent them some fact sheets all about her pets and lots of information about her duties and jobs.



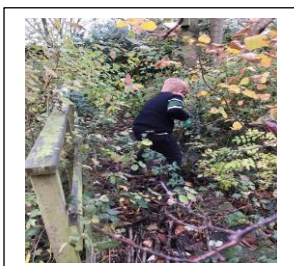
BOOK AMNESTY
