

We have continued our learning about frogs and we have found out about the life cycle of a frog.




Our healthy eating topic focused on dairy foods this week – we tasted different cheese



Class 2


We continued our topic exploring holidays in Victorian times. We used old photographs and post cards to learn about the different things people did on holiday at the seaside.






Class 3
