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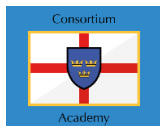
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Summary of impact from 2017 - 2018

- Competing successfully in many sporting events including swimming galas, cross country tournaments, basketball and athletics events
- Pupils signing up to join outside clubs e.g. gymnastics and karate following taster sessions held in school
- Increased swimming success – 93% of pupils in Year 6 achieved 25m with many able to swim far greater distances and become proficient in all strokes including butterfly
- Pupil engagement and resilience – pupils are keen to take on challenges, to take risks and to work together as a team.



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
