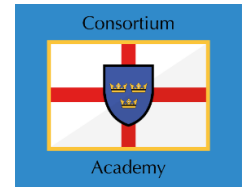

THIS WEEK IN CLASS

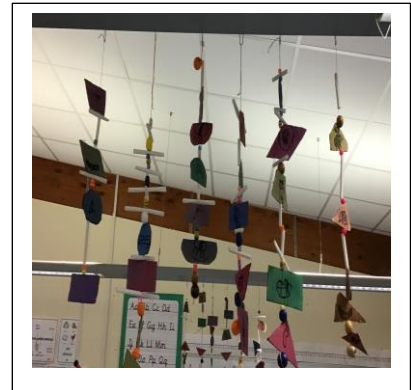
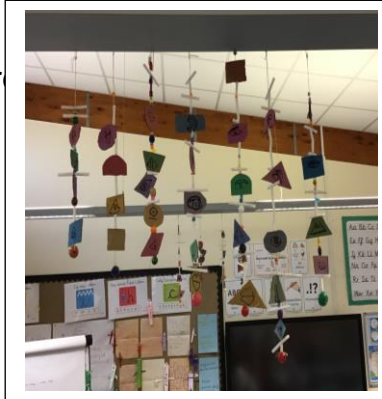
Class 1
